Dear Mr. President:

The Governors appoint annually to
the staff of this Faculty

- (a) an instructor in Household Science
- (b) a supervisor of practice-teaching at Ryerson School
- (c) a supervisor of practice-teaching at Jarvis St. Collegiate Inst.

The remuneration in each case is \$100 for the Session and the amount therefor is included in this year's appropriations.

I recommend that Miss E.M. Eadie of the Department of Household Science, and Mr. W.E. Groves, of Ryerson School, respectively, who have held the first two posts for some years be reappointed for the Current Session. I recommend also that Mr. John Jeffries, M.A., who has succeeded Dr. Embree as the Principal of the Jarvis St. Collegiate Inst., be appointed to the vacant post in that Institute.

Dear Sir:-

I am directed by the Minister of Education to notify you that, in view of applications to this Department from graduates of the Faculties of Education to be relieved of their obligation to teach in the schools of the Ontario Provincial System the first year of their teaching experience, he has decided as follows:

(1) Any University graduate, qualified to teach in the High Schools, will be relieved permanently of the aforesaid obligation on his presenting to this Department on or before the 31st of December next a receipt from the Bursar of the University for the sum of \$50. in addition to the fee which he has already paid for the courses at the Faculty of Education. Until December the 31st, the Minister will accept the applicant's agreement to comply with the aforesaid condition.

(2) Any other graduate of the Faculty of Education will also be permanently relieved of the aforesaid obligation on presentation to this Department on or before the 31st of December next a receipt from the Bursar of the University concerned for the sum of \$50. in addition to the fee which he has already paid for the courses at the Faculty, provided, however, that the Minister has relieved him until December 31st of the aforesaid obligation to teach in this Province, on the ground that the applicant is unable to obtain a position in the schools of the Ontario Provincial System.

(3) The aforesaid fee of \$50. shall be returned to the teacher by the University concerned at any time in the future when he presents to the University a certificate from the Minister that he has taught successfully at least one year in one or more of the school of the Provincial System for which he is legally qualified.
